NOTE: Familysearch.org has announced it will discontinue its microfilm lending as of September 1, and the last day to order is August 31, 2017. This is due to their progress in digitizing the microfilm, which should all be completed by 2020. In the meantime, those without a computer or those of us who would like some of the microfilm not yet digitized will be impacted. The former will need to use the FHL library on E. King Street to access those digitized images. It looks as if the world is beginning to keep its records on the cloud and this is another example of that.
