Article I: Name, Purpose, and Policies

Bandit Takes Police Guns But Is Slain

NEW YORK (P) — A shotgun-wielding bandit disarmed four policemen responding to a Bronx drugstore holdup alarm last night, then was shot and killed in an exchange of gunfire with police outside the store.

The gunman was tentatively identified as Lawrence C. McIn. tosh, 22, of Manhattan, a Negro. An accomplice got away, apparently with the \$300 taken during the holdup.

Police gave this account: The two robbers entered the store of druggist Irving Kanny on 3rd Avenue. Kanny tripped a silent alarm, alerting police.

Police Disarmed

When two patrolmen responded, Kanny was behind the counter and a man — who later turned out to be one of the robbers — was in a phone booth making a call.

However, the shotgun-wielding robber suddenly appeared, held the weapon to the head of one patrolman and told both officers to drop their revolvers. They did.

Moments later, a police sergeant and another patrolman entered. The robber, still holding the sawed-off shotgun at one policeman's head, forced the two newcomers to drop their revolvers.

Then, after picking up three of the policemen's guns and firing his weapon into a wall, the shotgun-bearing bandit and his accomplice backed out the front door.

Waiting Police Shoot

Not known to the pair was that two other patrolmen were waiting outside at the police sergeant's orders.

As the robbers emerged, Patrolman Daniel Bender opened fire at the one carrying the shotgun and police pistols. The man fell down, then got up, cast away his shotgun and fired back with a pistol. He got off six shots, two striking a patrol car. Bender and the other outside

\$175 Million Teacher Fund Deficit Seen

ALBANY (P) — The counsel for the State Teacher Retirement System says the fund has a \$175-million deficit and cannot afford to reduce the amount of revenue it collects from school districts.

Charles A. Brind, chief legal adviser to the system, declared yesterday that misunderstanding was responsible for much of the criticism by local school officials who charge that the fund is taking in too much money.

Brind defended the system's financial operations at a closed meeting with school officials from Long Island, Syracuse, Schenectady and Niagara Falls.

The possibility of court action to force the system to reduce the amount it takes in from school districts has been raised by some Long Island school officials.

No Threat of Suits

Brind said, however, that no threats of court action had been made at yesterday's session.

The local officials argued that the system could reduce payments in the next school year by approximately \$33 million, and the sum could be applied toward other school expenses.

The State Retirement System covers school districts outside of New York City, which has its own teachers-pension plan.

17 P.C. of Payroll

Districts in the state system have a total payroll of \$309 million and will contribute 17 per cent of that amount to the retirement plan for the school fiscal year beginning July 1.

Critics of the retirement system policy argue that it has overcome its deficiencies and must, by law, cut the rate for the coming year.

Officials of the fund contend that the rate must remain at 17 per cent to achieve a sound financial position.

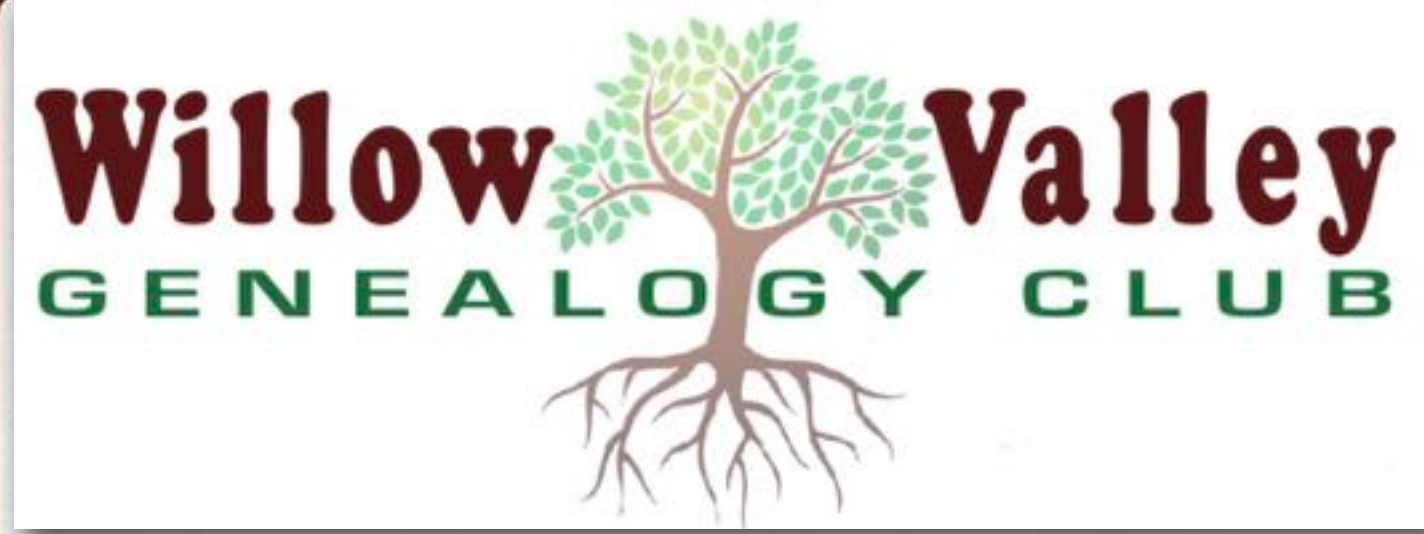
