I was born into a family of 6, 3 girls 3 boys; I was the youngest, on July 18, 1907 in Nienburg/Weser in Germany. I still remember that we had a pump for water, outside the house, right in front of the entrance.

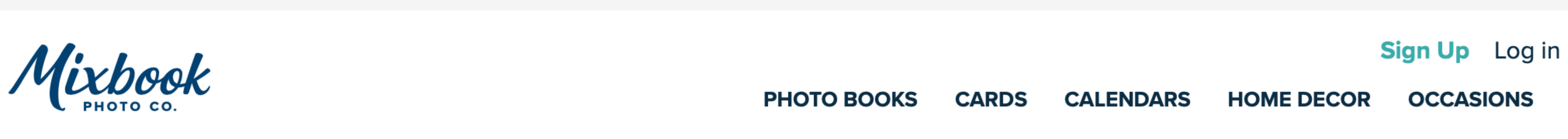
On Sundays we all went together for long walks along the Rolldamm (a walk along the Weser River). We also had a beautiful walk along the Hohe Wall (High Wall) along the Weser River and all around the inner City.

With 7 years, I started public school in Nienburg. This was about 10 minutes walk from our house.

I was sent out of town once during my school years for a 6 week vacation to Lüneburg, which was from the City Social Department. I remember of being very homesick the first couple of days, but we had sisters (nuns) sitting at bedtime on our beds and singing us to sleep with guitar music.

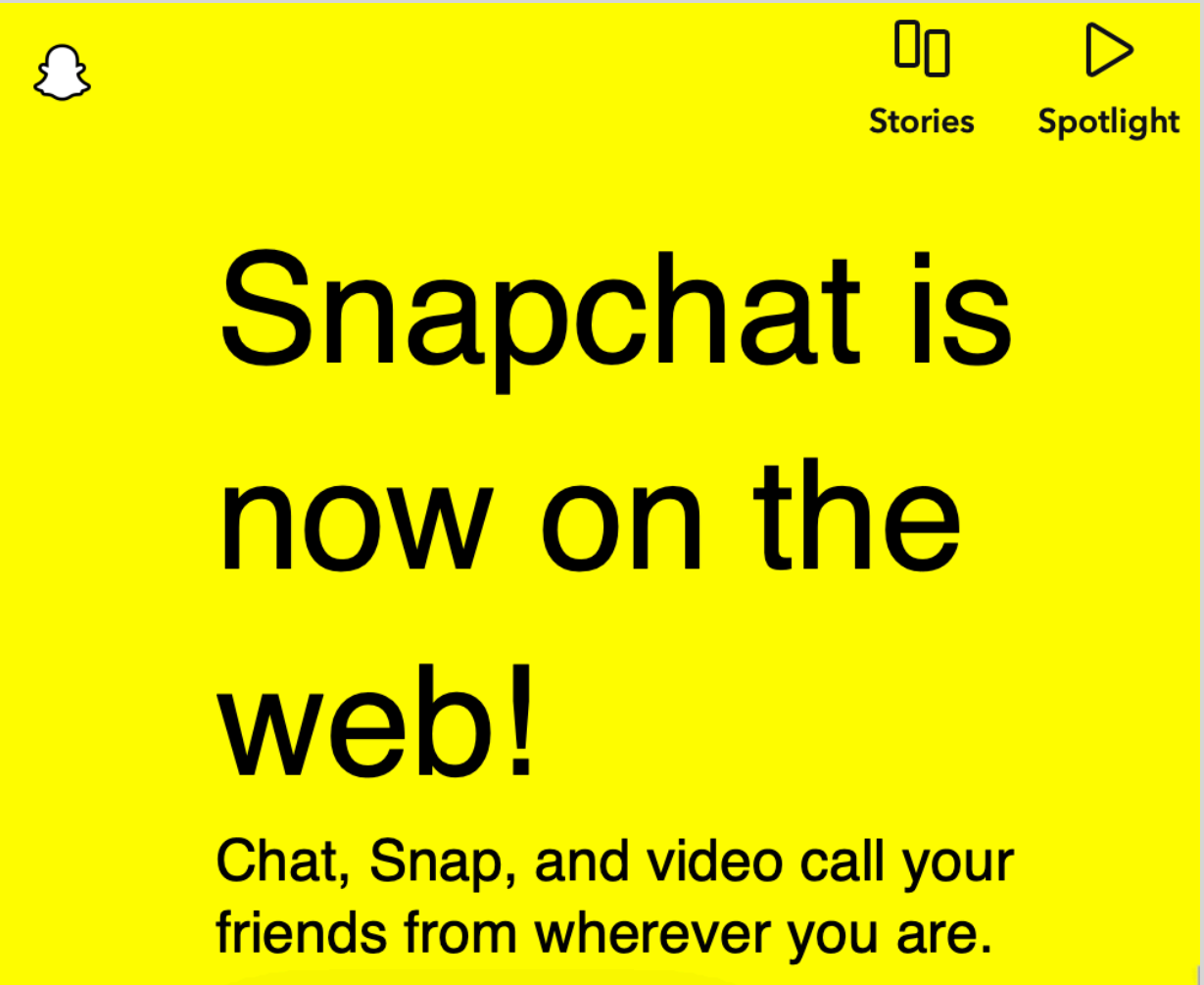
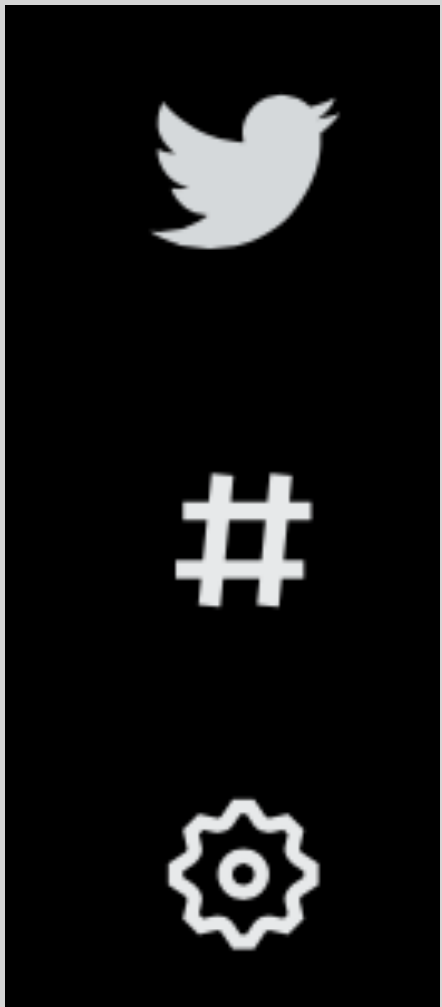

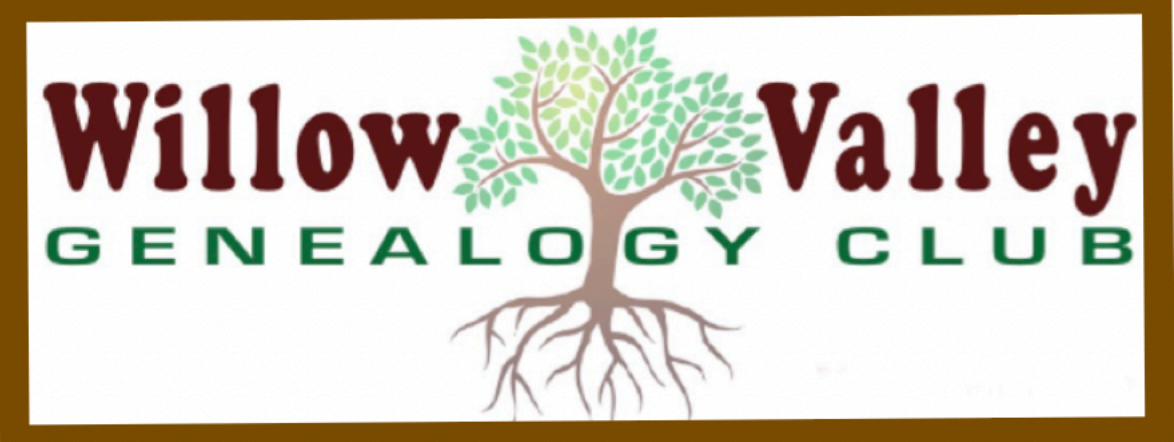
