



if you weren't interested in history... then why in genealogy?

- Wikipedia calls genealogy "the making of a pedigree"
- First tree by Louis III Duke of Würtemburg (ruled 1568-1598)
- PAF by Mormons in 1983 for \$35, DOS based
- Grown to a \$5.4B/yr industry
- DNA first introduced to general public in 2005 by NatGeo & IBM
- Dozens of DNA test sites..hereditary diseases, crime solver, genealogy

- Roots Magic 9 \$15 on Amazon.. most popular among genealogists

- Legacy 9 \$40-\$100 Win onl..Best set of reports & charts
- My Heritage Family Tree Builder...best free
- FamilySearch free..limited to one tree..offered by Mormon Church

What kind of computer? and a printer is helpful too


- Most software runs on either Windows PCs or Mac

- Used refurbished MacBook and Windows machines available for residents
- Windows PCs are the most popular, MacBooks less so

- Ancestry has 30B records..Best choice but most expensive..DNA too
- FamilySearch has 18B records
- Newspapers dot com has 25K newspapers 1700s-2000s \$8 to \$20/mo

- Internet <u>archive.org</u> 839B web pages Free
- Archives .com \$10 11.8B records
- My Heritage 19.6B records..Top choice of top10.com
